Making Adjustments Once A Pass Code Has Been Set:

Once the correct pass code has been <u>re-entered</u>, the instrument will allow you to scroll through all parameters ONCE to make alterations. You will need to re-enter your pass code for each subsequent attempt at programming.

Procedure to TURN ON the PASS CODE:

1) Scroll through menu using **F** until you reach **PASS** - Select your new code by pressing **A** or **A** Press **B** to save.

2) Scroll through menu using **F** until you reach LeVel - Select **O** or **1** by pressing **D** or **D**. Press **D** to save.

Procedure to CHANGE the LEVEL setting:
3) Scroll through menu using 🖥 until you reach PASS - Select your existing code by pressing 🛆 or 🔽 Press 🗳 to save.
4) Scroll through menu using 🖡 until you reach Level - Select 0 or 1 by pressing 🛆 or 🔽. Press 🖵 to save.
Procedure to TURN OFF the PASS CODE:

5) Scroll through menu using **F** until you reach **PASS** - Select your existing code by pressing **D** or **D** Press **D** to save.

6) AGAIN, Scroll through menu using **F** until you reach **PASS** - RESET the code to **O** by pressing **D** or **D**. Press **D** to save.

If the Pass code is forgotten, you may reset this as follows:-

Switch off power to the instrument. Press and hold  $\mathbf{M}$  whilst power is re-applied. The passcode has been disabled (reset back to  $\mathbf{0}$ ). All other settings will be retained.
